Public Transport	Get a monthly/annual pass	At ATAC sales points (newsagents', tobacco shops, etc.) or at ATAC ticket offices		
Health Insurance (not mandatory)	Register with the Italian National Health Service for free: bring your European Health Insurance Card and the E106 form (also called S1 form) N.B. If you do not have the E106 form you can register, but you have to pay about 150 euro	At Local Health Service Offices (ASL)
